Volunteer Description: Get to the Pointe! Sexual Health Conference for Youth Volunteer

Purpose

The Get to the Pointe! Sexual Health Conference For Youth is an annual conference put on in February for four alternative high schools in the Pointe Saint-Charles area. Organised by Saint-Columba House, the YMCA and ACCM, this conference invites local community organisations to present various sexual health related workshops and kiosks to the students of these schools. There is also an art contest to encourage youth to think about sexual health through the lens of various art based media. The volunteer that will take on this position will be a part of the Planning Committee that is responsible for contributing to the planning and execution of the daylong conference. We are looking for a candidate who has multiple skill sets to take on this role.

Main Responsibilities

- Develop and facilitate trainings for students within the schools to build their capacity around animating sexual health workshops
- Co-facilitate sexual health workshops with students and promote the conference throughout the school year
- Manage social networking sites to promote and provide information about the conference
- All E4P volunteers are expected to facilitate kiosks and workshops when necessary
- Any other duties as required by the Planning Committee and E4P department

Personal qualifications and skills

- Experience/knowledge in HIV/AIDS, Hep C, sexuality, sexual health
- Commitment to principles of harm reduction and anti-oppression
- Experience working with youth and in youth program development
- Strong workshop facilitation skills
- Promotions and managing social networking sites
- Fundraising and securing small scale donations to give out as student prizes an asset
- Experience in art and expressing different themes through various media
- Strong spoken English and French (able to present workshops in either languages)
- Ability to work autonomously and in a team

Time Commitment

In addition to E4P training and Volunteer Orientation, expect to give four hours per week. All volunteers are required to make a six month commitment.
