Volunteer Description: MSM Party Kiosker

Purpose

Our Education for Prevention (E4P) department gets invited to provide sexual health kiosks at numerous parties for men who have sex with men (MSM) in Montreal. We're looking for enthusiastic, night owl volunteers to help us run these late-night kiosks! Kiosks involve handing out condoms and pamphlets, answering sexual health questions, and making referrals to our Kontak and SextEd programs. Kiosks generally last for the first two to three hours of the party and once the kiosk is done and packed up, volunteers get free admission for the rest of the event!

Main Responsibilities

- Pick up (and sometimes pack and prepare) materials at ACCM before the event
- Transport materials to event
- Set up kiosk, hand out condoms and pamphlets, answer sexual health questions, and make referrals to ACCM's programs and services
- Engage guests with welcoming and friendly demeanor
- Keep track of the number of people who access kiosk
- Return materials to ACCM during office hours
- All E4P volunteers are expected to do kiosks and workshops when necessary
- Any other duties as required by the Kontak Coordinator

Personal Qualifications and Skills

- Excellent sexual health knowledge
- Commitment to principles of harm reduction and anti-oppression
- Knowledge or experience working with or being part of the MSM community
- Comfortable and open to research and talk about issues surrounding sexuality and sexual health
- Excellent communication skills in English and French
- Friendly and outgoing personality
- Reliable and flexible with scheduling
- Access to a car is an asset

Time Commitment

In addition to Volunteer Orientation and E4P Training, expect to give four hours per week. All volunteers are asked to make a six month commitment.
