## Volunteer Description: Testing Blogger Volunteer

### **Purpose**

As some people have experienced, getting tested in Montreal is sometimes not the easiest feat. The E4P Department believes that every citizen should have easy access to getting tested so to facilitate this process, we are looking for a volunteer blogger who will establish a blog to provide accurate and up to date information on various testing sites in Montreal, demystify the testing process by writing about their personal experiences as well as encouraging others to contribute and give their personal perspective on what their experiences were like.

### **Main Responsibilities**

- Research the testing sites available in Montreal
- Call each testing site every three months to ensure that the blog has up to date information
- Write about your experience at each testing site
- Recruit others to write about their experiences getting tested at various testing sites in Montreal
- All E4P volunteers are expected to facilitate kiosks and workshops when necessary
- Any other duties as required by the department

### **Personal qualifications and skills**

- Experience/knowledge in HIV/AIDS, Hep C, sexuality, sexual health
- Commitment to principles of harm reduction and anti-oppression
- Experience in blogging and maintaining a blog
- Comfortable and open to talk about issues surrounding sexuality
- Excellent spoken and written English, French an asset
- Ability to work autonomously and in a team

### **Time Commitment**

In addition to E4P training and Volunteer Orientation, expect to give four hours per week. All volunteers are required to make a six month commitment.
